1. This event is promoted by the Wellington Triumph Sports Car Club Inc. under the MotorSport New Zealand Inc. National Sporting Code its applicable Appendices and Schedules, the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events (as contained in Appendix Five - Schedule C) and these Supplementary Regulations.

3. The MotorSport NZ permits for this meeting are tba for a Clubsport Advanced Event (Standing Sprint (Dual Car)) and tba for a Clubsport Basic Event (Standing Sprint (Single Car))
4. The Competition will be held on **Sunday 23 September 2018** at the Masterton Motorplex, Masterton. There will be a driver's briefing, with roll call at 8.30am at the Commentary Box. **Attendance is compulsory.** Competition will commence at 10am.
5. Scrutineering and documentation as per Schedule A or AA of the current NZ Motorsport Manual will be at the venue from 7.30am on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> September (Sept) and also may additionally be held at a venue to be announced, from 5.30pm to 7.00pm on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> Sept and 3.00pm-5.00pm on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> Sept.
6. The venue is the Masterton Motorplex. Access is via 21 Manaia Rd, Solway, Homebush 5885. The surface is sealed and approximately 800 metres in length.  
**Vehicle access is unrestricted in the designated paddocks – DO NOT block any roadways. Follow the instructions of the marshals.**
7. Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close at 8am on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2018.  
**FEES:** The entry fee is \$100.00 (no GST applicable) and MUST accompany the official application form, which is attached. **ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER 5.00PM ON FRIDAY 21<sup>st</sup> SEPTEMBER 2018 WILL BE DEEMED LATE AND WILL INCUR AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$50.00.**  
Applications are to be made on the correct form and to be deemed valid must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate fees. Applications can be gained from the Event Secretary.  
**Payment can be made by direct credit to our BNZ account 02-0536-0052466-00 (Wellington Triumph). Include your name and the word "Drags" in the payment!**  
Acceptance will be at the organising committee's discretion and as a result of meeting scrutineering requirements. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any application in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code and these regulations.  
Acceptance of entry will not be sent out. Unsuccessful applicants will, however, be notified.

The organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if less than 40 entries are received at the closing date. The maximum number of starters will be 80 with the option of running an additional five reserves at the discretion of the Clerk of Course on the day. Any additional entries will be placed on the reserve list. In signing the application form competitors are deemed to fully understand the relevant articles and regulations as contained in the current NZ MotorSport Manual. This is also a declaration that the vehicle they are competing in is up to all required standards.

**ALL DRIVERS MUST POSSESS AND PRODUCE THE FOLLOWING FOR INSPECTION AT SCRUTINEERING/DOCUMENTATION:**

- Current MotorSport New Zealand Competition Licence
- Current MotorSport New Zealand Affiliated Car Club Membership card
- Tyres intended for use at the events
- Log Book (where issued)

Slick tyres are allowed at this event. Where slick tyres are used, competitors will be given two opportunities to warm up their tyres prior to each run.

All vehicles must display the scrutineering sticker provided.

Competitors are responsible for providing competition numbers for at least the left hand side of their car, Officials will also write on competitors windscreens with white shoe polish.

All vehicles must be presented in a clean, tidy condition.

All vehicles must be running properly. Make sure your car works before you arrive.

Dual driver cars are permitted (no more than two drivers per car).

**ANY DRIVERS WISHING TO TAKE PASSENGERS MUST BE SCRUTINEERED TO DO SO.**

8. It is the organising committee's intention that all competitors will complete a minimum of three qualifying runs except where a competitor fails to start when requested, that competitor will forfeit that run. For qualifying, competitors are expected to line up without having to be asked. The format of the day is covered in a separate document. Qualifying results will be established using each competitor's fastest morning runs, unless competitors wish to substitute their fastest morning run for an adjusted time. These adjusted times will then be used along with other competitors fastest actual qualifying times for the afternoon elimination runs. For the afternoon session, once eliminated, competitors may continue with heads up grudge racing.
9. Classes and running groups will be advised on Sunday morning after qualifying.
10. Up to four vehicles may perform demonstration runs at times during the day.
11. Passengers will be permitted to travel in all runs. Please let the Chief Scrutineer know at scrutineering whether you intend to participate with passengers so that your car can be scrutineered for compliance. Drivers are required to ensure all passengers wear appropriate safety equipment, which must also be available for scrutineering. Passengers must sign the appropriate indemnity form, have the chosen hand stamped (we'll let you know which hand) and **MUST** attend the 8.30am drivers briefing.  
**Car and passenger must comply with the requirements as set out in Schedules A and C.**
12. Times will be available at the venue during competition. A complete set of results will be published as soon as practical following the conclusion of the event. Results will be declared final 30 minutes after the last run of the day. Any competitor withdrawing from the event should immediately notify the Secretary.
13. Competitors are requested to drive considerately to and from the event. Alcohol and drugs are not permitted.
14. Following the conclusion of the competition a prizegiving will be held.  
TIME and VENUE: To be advised at Drivers Briefing.

***N.B.** Attendance at prizegiving is expected.*

- Entry fee must accompany official application form \$100.00 OR \$150.00 (Late entry)
